As a family-run hotel, preserving the natural beauty of our region for future generations is especially important to us. For us, sustainability goes beyond environmental responsibility—we also strive to foster fair and equitable social relationships.

Our commitment is reflected in our daily actions, through both small and significant steps, which we are pleased to share with you on the following pages.

We are proud to contribute to a greener, fairer, and more sustainable future, and we would be delighted if you joined us on this journey.

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We use sustainable alternatives in our rooms and pay particular attention to environmentally friendly solutions:



Instead of individually packaged **guest supplies**, we provide reusable products to reduce waste.



Our **guest folder**, containing all relevant information, is **digitized** and can be conveniently accessed via any internet-enabled device.



We deliberately do without down bedding and instead use **allergy-friendly** and **environmentally friendly materials**.



To reduce plastic waste, we offer **complimentary drinks** in the rooms exclusively in glass bottles.



To optimize the consumption of **cleaning agents**, we use **dosing pumps** that dispense the exact amount required.



We avoid using chemical cleaning agents as much as possible, instead opting for **biodegradable** and **environmentally friendly alternatives**.



We actively encourage our guests to forgo **daily room cleaning** and to **reuse towels** in order to conserve resources.



Instead of plastic key cards, we deliberately use **traditional keys** that do not have to be replaced regularly and are therefore more durable and environmentally friendly.



We aim to reduce energy consumption and conserve resources. To achieve this, we take the following steps:



Green electricity and LED lighting

We only use green electricity and long-life LEDs to save energy and reduce maintenance costs.



Motion detectors in public

In areas that do not require constant lighting, we have installed motion detectors to further reduce electricity consumption.



Avoidance of energy-intensive devices

Minibars and air conditioning are intentionally excluded from our rooms. Instead, we provide a central vending machine for drinks and snacks in the lobby and energy-efficient fans in all rooms.



Demand-based heating

To save energy and reduce our ecological footprint, unused rooms are kept unheated.



Outdoor temperature-controlled heating control

By automatically adjusting to the outside temperature, our heating system improves comfort and reduces environmental impact.



Water-saving fittings

We have installed water-saving fittings throughout the hotel to reduce water consumption and energy consumption for hot water without compromising comfort.

Through these measures, we actively contribute to environmental protection while simultaneously improving the energy efficiency of our hotel.



Sustainable sourcing and nutrition are two key elements of our philosophy. We are actively committed to promoting environmentally friendly practices and supporting the local economy.

Below are the steps we have taken to contribute to sustainability in our restaurant:



Regional suppliers

When selecting our suppliers and products, we prioritize regional suppliers. We aim to source locally to minimize the environmental impact of transportation and support the economy in our region.



Our range of dishes

Our menu and breakfast buffet offer vegan and vegetarian options and cater for allergies and food intolerances. This selection not only promotes healthy nutrition, but also supports sustainable practices.



Seasonal cuisine

Our dishes change regularly, as we buy seasonally for the most part. In this way, we promote the use of fresh, local products and reduce the transportation emissions associated with long procurement routes. For the few imported products, we pay attention to organic certifications and fair trade labels.



Environmentally friendly packaging

We opt for to-go packaging made from renewable raw materials, which is compostable and has a low carbon footprint. Additionally, we rely on reusable bottles and avoid single-use plastic entirely.



Targeted purchasing management

We rely on targeted purchasing management to actively avoid food waste. Through careful planning and close cooperation with our suppliers, we ensure that we only purchase the quantities we actually need.

With these measures, we are contributing to more sustainable gastronomy, promoting the health of our guests and protecting the environment.



Sustainability and environmental protection are the focus of our business management. We are committed to using resources responsibly and reducing waste.

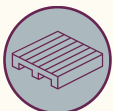
We have taken the following measures to ensure that we act in an environmentally conscious manner here too:

Professional disposal



We place great emphasis on the responsible disposal of batteries and hazardous substances such as paints and oils. Our processes comply with legal requirements and guarantee that these materials are properly recycled or disposed.

Purchasing in bulk



We purchase only non-perishable consumables in large containers in order to minimize packaging material and waste. This method reduces material consumption and contributes to sustainability through more efficient use of transportation resources.

Waste separation



We have set up waste separation stations on all floors, in the conference rooms and in the inner courtyard to make it easier to separate waste. We provide clear notices to inform our guests about the importance of waste separation and encourage environmentally conscious behavior.

Recycling plan



We carefully separate glass, paper, plastic and organic waste and have developed a comprehensive recycling plan. In internal meetings, we regularly discuss measures to prevent consumption and food waste, strategies to reduce waste and effective recycling and disposal methods.

Processing food leftovers



Our food waste is professionally collected by organic waste disposal companies and processed in biogas plants to generate environmentally friendly energy. We also have the waste oil collected by a specialist company for further processing.

Through these measures, we actively contribute to the responsible use of resources and thus reduce our ecological footprint.



Diversity and inclusion are core values at our hotel. We are actively committed to promoting diversity in our team and creating a respectful working environment in which all employees feel valued.

We have implemented the following measures to promote an inclusive and respectful working environment:



Promoting diversity

We ensure that all genders and identities have equal opportunities in recruitment, career development and pay. By removing barriers, we create an inclusive environment that supports and promotes employees with different abilities.

The health of our employees is important to us. We have therefore introduced private supplementary insurance that goes beyond statutory health insurance. This insurance guarantees access to extended health services such as specialized treatments, shorter waiting times and better medical care.



Fair working conditions

We offer fair wages, fair working hours and long-term prospects so that our employees feel valued and supported. We are convinced that a motivated team working under fair conditions forms the basis for the success of our hotel.

Through these measures, we promote a diverse and inclusive corporate culture that focuses the success and well-being of our employees.

Cooperation with sustainable laundry



We work with a sustainability-certified laundry that provides climate-neutral rental laundry. This partnership supports the Uganda Climate Protection Program, which provides households and schools in need with access to modern, climate-friendly drinking water treatment systems.

Annual Christmas dinner



As part of our commitment to the community, we host an annual Christmas dinner for the homeless. In cooperation with local organizations and business partners, we organize a festive meal and a meaningful holiday experience for those in need.

Sponsoring local sports clubs



We support local sports clubs and sponsors, e.g. by providing equipment or organizing Christmas parties for their youth teams. Through these efforts, we inspire young athletes and support their sporting growth.
